

**2006 UPPER DECK TICKET TO THE HALL SWEEPSTAKES

6	<p>UNCLAIMED GRAND PRIZE (Second Chance Drawing): Unclaimed Grand Prize not awarded in instant-win game will be awarded in a 2nd Chance random drawing on or about January 5, 2007 from among all eligible entries received for this drawing.
